The Government is planning to spend \$360milion on replacing a superior heavy rail infrastructure in Newcastle with light rail that has not got very good large volumes of people transporting capabilities.

This is bad planning. A better use of money is to spend \$120Million on lifting the heavy rail at Wickham over the Hannel street road where traffic gets held up by the rail movements.
