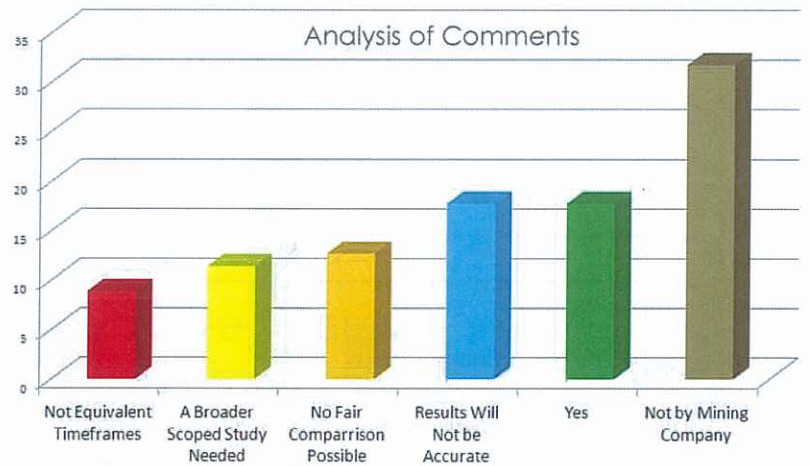

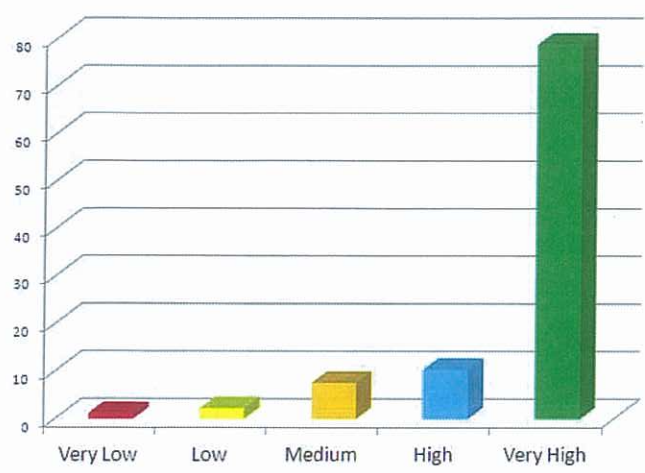

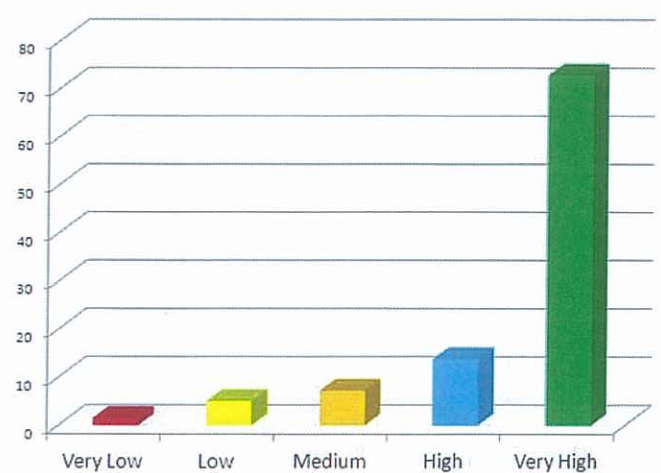

7. Please rate the importance of the impact of Water Security Issues attributable to mining?

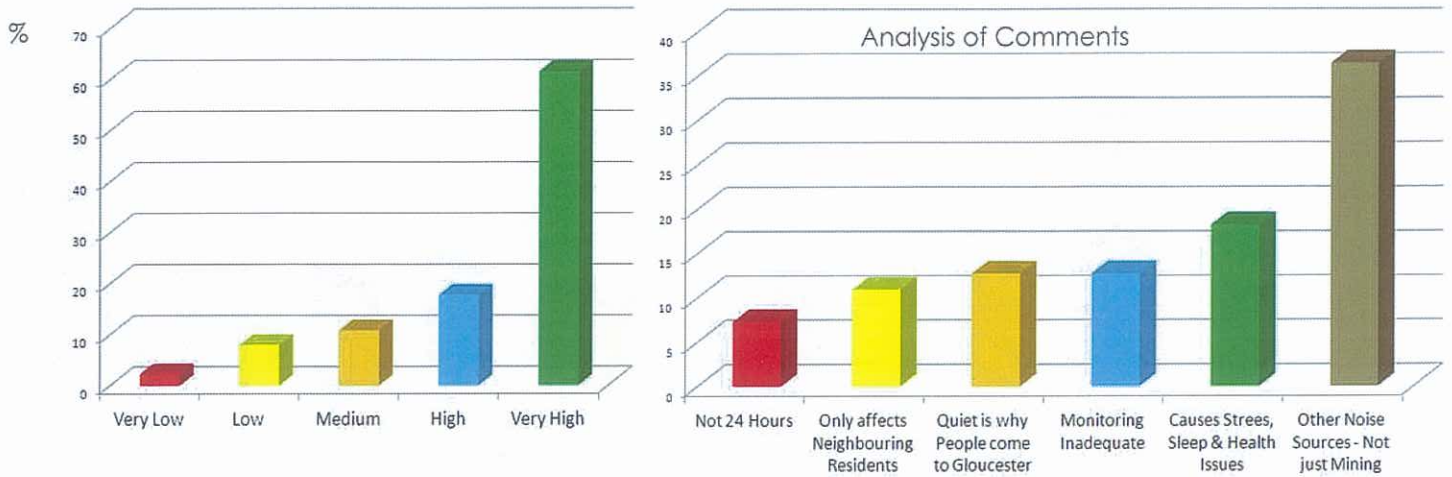

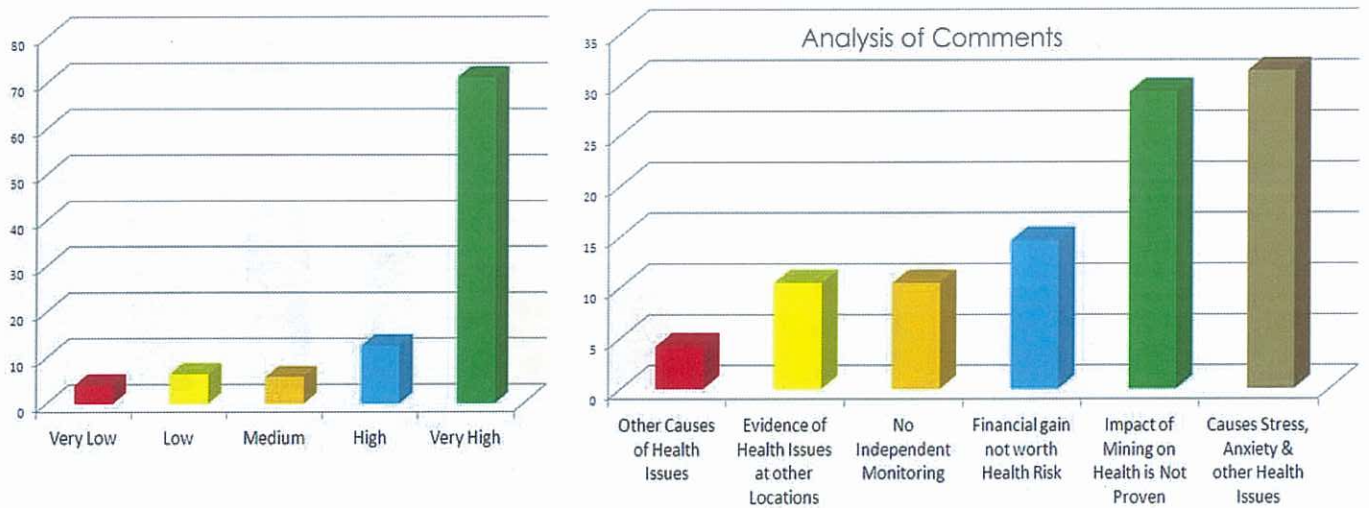

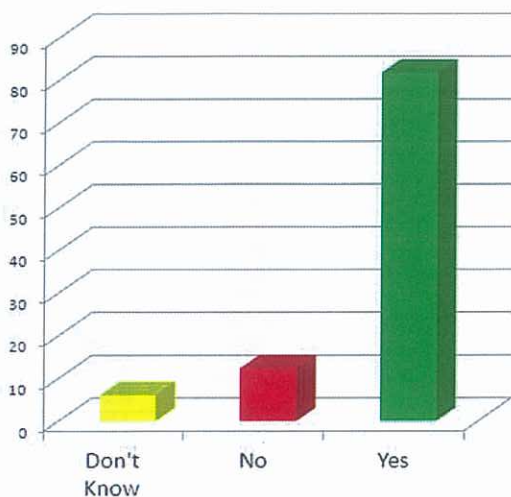
