I am the mother of four fabulous young men age 17 to 24. My oldest son is in a long term and committed gay relationship. As a parent it breaks my heart to hear him become saddened and angered by the fact that he cannot celebrate his love for his partner through legal marriage as do non gay couples. We will be traveling to attend their commitment ceremony next year, however, I strongly support their right to a legal and binding marriage.
