Electricity security

Technical developments are rapidly changing electricity supply and use. Progressive countries are transitioning from fossil fuel to renewable energy generation.

Energy storage device technology research, development and use are growing. Higher capacity and more efficient batteries are in use. Research provides ongoing improvement. Smart grids are used to assist balance of generation and demand.

The current fragmented NSW election generation, storage, connection, development and research should be integrated, with management controlled by a Government "Electricity Commission". This process was effective and efficient after WW2.

This will be increased if water is produced. Half of this goes to foreigners. At the end of lease the lessees own the plant and site outright.

Will you please state publicly and clearly for the benefit of all NSW and the Christian Democrat Party that you will oppose any sale, lease of fragmentation of the NSW electricity system.
