Subject: Call For NSW Inquiry Into CSG

PLEASE demand the establishment of a Royal Commission, with appropriate terms of reference, to fully and independently investigate the impacts of the industry and the processes used on agriculture and other industries, on community and individual health, on environmental values including the health of our water systems, both surface and underground.

PLEASE demand coal seam gas exploration and mining to be made subject to all relevant environmental legislation, including the native vegetation and water management laws.

PLEASE demand the provision of a right in the Petroleum (Onshore) Act to allow landholders to refuse consent for coal seam gas exploration or production on their land.

PLEASE demand a prohibition on coal seam gas exploration and mining in important bushland, valuable farmland, groundwater aquifers, residential areas and public lands.

PLEASE demand a requirement that all chemicals used in coal seam gas drilling or fracking must be assessed by the chemical regulator for use for that purpose before being approved for use.

PLEASE demand that the community have the final say on whether this industry is to be allowed to operate in NSW.
