Please stop greyhound racing. Greyhounds don't deserve the early deaths (by age 4-5) they are experiencing because they become of no use to the industry and their owners. The industry even recommends members euthanize their dogs, which are not adopted in NSW - (Tony O'Mara Growth & Sustainability GRNSW) and only 5% are ever adopted.

"It is the preferred option that greyhounds be adopted or humanely euthanized by a Veterinary Surgeon. It is not appropriate for greyhounds to be handed in to Council pounds."

We rescue from pounds are vets where greyhounds are due to be euthanized.
