Dear Mr Beale

I write regarding the 3 July 2015 phone call you had with my Wagga Wagga electorate office regarding fuel excise revenue. Thank you for taking the time to contact me about this matter. I understand you will make a submission to the New South Wales Government's *Fit for the Future* program using this advice, as well as to an Upper House Inquiry.

As my staff member discussed with you, I have received advice from the Treasurer's office on your behalf regarding this matter.

Fuel taxes (that is, excise and excise-equivalent customs duty) apply to fuels used in Australia. The Australian Government uses revenue from excise, including fuel taxes, to fund essential services that all Australians receive benefits from, such as the delivery of social services, defence and security, road funding and numerous other areas of spending of benefit to the whole community. Fuel taxes raised \$18.3 billion in tax revenue in 2013-14.

You may also be interested to know that legislation to reintroduce biannual fuel excise indexation has passed both Houses of Parliament. This measure is expected to raise approximately \$3.6 billion over five years to the end of 2018-19. The reintroduction of indexation on fuel excise will give the Government access to secure funding for productivity enhancing road infrastructure projects.

I trust this information will assist you with your submissions to the New South Wales Government and Upper House Inquiry.
