My submission concerns AGED CARE PROVISIONS in the Metropolitan area of Sydney.

There is a serious shortage of affordable housing for pensioners who have few or no assets.

The rental prices particularly in my area (2068 - Willoughby) are not affordable for those on a pension, even with Centrelink assistance.

We need a three-tier building to house at least 100 people and that will, in time, prove insufficient but it would be a good start. The three-tier facility should contain:

- 1. self care dwellings
- 2. dwellings attached to a facility providing care + meals
- 3. high care facilities for those with a medical condition (such as incontinence, or diagnosed conditions cancer MS CFS Chronic Pain and the resulting disability all those who are unable to dress, clean or care for themselves in dwellings 1 or 2.

We also need to provide a facility for those suffering from mental illness - not just a centre where they can go to be distracted and entertained but somewhere with medical care and medication as required under supervision.
