**Re: Inquiry into Greyhound Racing in New South Wales**

**(1) Welfare of Animals**

- Box traits should be noted after a number of starts that is a dog that repeatedly crashes to the left or right be boxed inside or outside to minimise any collisions thus resulting in less injuries to the dogs.

**(2) Reducing Euthanasia and Prosecutions**

- Lower graded dogs need to be able to be raced. If the system would allow for this to happen fewer dogs would be retired and or euthanised.
- More access for adoption dogs, greyhounds seem to have to be model dogs, where as other breeds are worse.

**(3) Box Draws**

- There should be more transparency on box draws it is not uncommon for a dog and or trainer to get poor boxes eg. A dog has 10 starts and has come up with box 6 six times. How can the random computer box draw do this if this was a good system.
