the injury and death statistics from Greyhound Freedom have been updated to the following:

From Jan 2012 to Sep 2013:

- 324 greyhounds died at the track. They either collapsed on the track, in the catching pen or were euthanized as a result of their injuries.

- 532 greyhounds had fractures. 90% of greyhounds with fractures are not raced again or not breed with.

- 132 greyhounds were scratch from a race because they were dead

- There were 31 186 injuries. These greyhounds were scratched from a race due to injuries or they suffered an injury from a race.

this is appalling to say the least, greyhound racing is cruel and barbaric and only exists for the entertainment and monetary greed of humans, it does not help greyhounds in fact the opposite, it is not humane to force these beautiful greyhounds to race solely for the greed of human kind, let alone the number of greyhounds who suffer and/or do not survive a race or are euthanized when they are no longer useful to the owners !
