Recommendation 1 Procedure - Independent review

Requirement for external review at clearly defined milestones. Includes a focus on detailed approval of delivery in the context of wider project integration with broader infrastructure and policy objectives.

Recommendation 3 Leadership - Direct contact with the community

A greater level of direct contact between community based organisations and relevant government Ministers and the Premier.

Recommendation 4 Leadership - Independent Quality Audits

Provide Government Ministers and Premier with independent assessment of project performance against policy.
