Many areas in the wattagans state forest that had popular dirt bike trails have in recent months undergone extensive logging operations which result in much higher level of damage to the forest than through any of the dirt bike use. We already have the most sensitive parts of our land marked as national parks that do not allow off road vehicles. I strongly believe that limiting space in state forests any further is not warranted especially when you consider the extensive logging operations in areas that are proposed to be banned to offroad vehicles.
