our business supplied catering for visiting days to the gaol

it is an integral part of the town. It not only provides employment but growth in the diversity of the town with new staff moving in. Obviously being fairly well paid the employees provide a very big influence on the economy of not only Garfton but the Clarence Valley.

How will the closure or downsizing of Grafton Jail affect employment opportunities in your community?

Our business had to put off one staff member due to the closure, This will happen in small businesses across Grafton and the wider Clarence Valley. It is the flow on effect.
