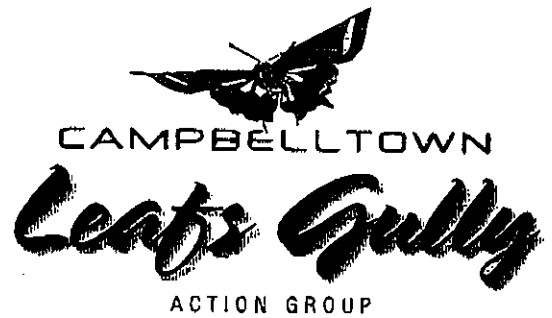

RE: HEALTH IMPACTS OF AIR POLLUTION IN THE SYDNEY BASIN

We refer to the above and advise that AGL is currently preparing documentation relating to a Part 3A Application (under the EP&A Act) for a Gas Fired Power Station in the Campbelltown Local Government Area.

The power plant will cause air emissions comprising carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide and nitrogen oxides to the southwest region, a region already under significant pressure from air pollution. We are alarmed at the impacts this would have on life styles and health of the existing community and potential future communities.

It is our strong belief that the enquiry would need to consider the impacts of this Power Station.

Data and Reports regarding air quality (relating to the proposal) are still to be presented by AGL. Time needs to be given to undertake analysis of these reports and then to present our findings to the enquiry.

As such, we strongly feel that the closing date for submissions needs to be extended to allow for this process to occur.
