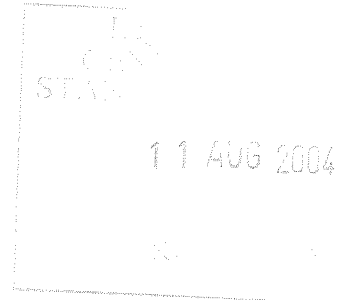

I, Nadia Dillo, am currently employed as manager of Fletcher Jones, Shop 62 at the Designer Outlets in Liverpool.

I am writing to you to express my disappointment over the pending closure of the Centre and to help you understand how this will affect me on a personal level as well as the other 450 plus employees.

If Orange Grove were to close I would find myself unemployed for the first time in 15 years. At 48 years of age, obtaining another permanent / part time job opportunity in the local area would be near impossible. This could result in me taking unemployment benefits.

I have two daughters to support and have just been approved to buy my family home. This will no longer be possible and with no money coming in the rent will be far too high. I would no longer be able to help support my family back home so therefore this closure will not only affect one family but two.

So please I am asking for you to listen to our stories and please support us by keeping the Designer Outlets open.
