We would like to see personal amounts of possession and cultivation of cannabis made legal.

For larger amounts we would like to see a licence required and made available through amendments made to the NSW HEMP INDUSTRY ACT 2008 and other appropriate Acts, allowing licences to cultivate high THC cannabis for commercial reasons such as medical use. Hemp is just low THC cannabis.
