Key Points for my Submission are as follows:

- Historically marriage has been between a man and a woman with the intent of procreation. Procreation is naturally only between a man and a woman and no society or government should ever seek to change what has been created naturally.
- It is unconstitutional for the NSW state government or any other state or territory to submit a bill of this type. It is a federal issue and should be dealt with under the Australian constitution.
