## **Dear Members**

I am a long-time resident of a for-profit Retirement Village in NSW and have had dealings on two occasions , in company with other residents, with our Village Operator in the Consumer, Trader and Tenancy Tribunal.

While holding no strong views on the principle of consolidating various NSW Tribunals, I wish to offer the following comments:

- 1. The expertise of CTTT Members in the area of Retirement Villages (in all its forms) should not be lost to other areas.
- 2. The ease of contact by residents should not be reduced.
- 3. The relatively low level of legal representation permitted in CTTT Hearings should be maintained . Indeed, the legal representation of both parties should be limited to ensure a "level playing field".
- 4. The decisions of CTTT Members should have wider impact (i.e. stronger legal standing as a precedent) beyond the specific case determined.
