- tailor learning program to child's individual interests and vocation
- more excursions and options for extracurricular activities
- more efficient and effective than attending up to six after the fact parent teacher interviews
- better family relationships
- comprehensive support network can draw on those with more/different experience
- multiple socialisation contexts

## Challenges:

- home schooling is a full time commitment, and requires community and government support to make the process as easy and efficient as possible
- exclusion from swimming and athletics for athletically gifted children
- no funding from government and no tax deductibility or rebates
- no option for hybrid program with part school and part home school
- inequality we should be able to include other tutors in our education program just as schools do
