

Be a nurse myself I find management do not take in consideration the work of those Officers they have to deal with human pain and horrible situation sometimes I know counselling is in place [but like in many place only paper work is done]. We are all human and we do not like failure and many time the person who need help be the last one to ask for it or never ask.

At the meeting with the management 3 years ago I ask for a debriefing every week for the officers on duty that week, nothing happen

One of the officers who was bad to Christine got a promotion

I believe the management has to change and god fearing people with human value to take over, I certainly do not want any others family to Suffer the way our family suffer, this is Christine battle for justice, and as her mother I will continue her fight for those officers who are in the same situation today I pray for a change into the ambulance of NSW I pray for a good result and also For each involve in decisions making
