The plan for a Metro was presented to the community as something that was going to happen and as far as I know no opinions were sought. I would welcome a rail connection to the city, almost enough to say that a Metro would be OK - but it was never a good idea.

I have ridden the Paris Metro and the London Tube system and standing for a few stations is quite acceptable.

We are too far from the City for a Metro.

We need a rail link, but one with rolling stock the same as the rest of the City Rail where there is a presumption that one will have a seat, and standing happens only when there is severe over crowding.

In summary I believe we need, and deserve a rail link - but not a Metro.
