----"I believe that current housing stock which are government assets paid for by the taxpayers of NSW, should remain an assest of the State. Under a similar arrangement to other State owned properties and assests which are either leased at peppercorn rent or contractually arranged as being under only a "Care,Control and Management" arrangement.

It is imperitive that these assets not be either gifted or sold to private service providers because once tenure passes those assets can be then sold by those service providers for the organisations profit. There have been other losses of a similar mannner ,such as the Crowle Home sie -" managed" by Achieve Australia, and now redevloped for private flats with , 15% usage for disabld people .

This means uncertainty for the most vulnerable people needing affordable housing, particularly people with disabilities. People, including people with disabilities, need housing in their community and many larger disability service providers have become businesses which regard the dollar as their prime consideration, not the welfare and well-being of the person with disability. Any government-owned housing stock should includes a contractual agreement that they be maintained so that they will remain available for disability housing in the community and an asset of the NSW taxpayer."
