This intersection, known as Graham Drive South, is a horror! It is located where an overtaking lane is about to end, and people in this lane are travelling fast.

Sight distance from Graham Drive is pitiful, due to a combination of a curve and a rise.

It is inconceivable that anyone with an ounce of common sense, let alone engineering qualifications, could ever allowed it to be built in the first place. But it was, and it is now a fatality

We cannot wait for a full by-pass, or a full up-grade, for this to be fixed. It has to be done now.
