I am very concerned that there is a proposal to cut the Hunter Line at Wickham and to terminate the Newcastle Line from Central at Broadmeadow.

At present we are able to access Sydney by rail interconnecting at Hamilton station. This is a vital link and the only way of conducting any business in Sydney without staying overnight. The four hours has already been reduced from four and half. No thought also seems to have been given to people from the Upper Hunter travelling on holiday from Sydney.
