I would like to make a submission to the committee inquiring into the Riverina Wine Industry. I would also like to speak to the committee in person if possible.

My main concerns regarding the industry are:

- 1. The large variation in prices offered for the same fruit by different wineries.
- 2. Contracts that are no more than supply agreements.
- 3. Variations to contracts from season to season resulting in the capping of tonnages accepted with very short notice to growers.
- 4. Lack of a base price or a guaranteed minimum price which reflects the costs of production.
- 5. No compensation for delays in harvesting fruit after it has reached the required baume which results in downgrading and loss of yield.
- 6. Standover tactics used by some wineries by threatening not to take growers fruit in future when complaints are made about price or business practices.
