**RE: INQUIRY INTO 'MR FLUFFY' ASBESTOS INSULTATION**

Thank you for addressing this matter. I am preparing this submission in my capacity as Director and owner of a small hazardous material laboratory and consultancy in regional New South Wales (NSW). We would like you to consider a couple of points, detailed below in reference to your terms of reference:

- 1 That the designated Local Government Areas (LGA) be expanded. We are receiving inquiries from various additional LGAs, including Tumut, Tumbarumba, Tamworth, Narromine, Dubbo, Wellington and Coonabarabran. I do not attempt to detail where the extra LGAs be, but suggest that expansion is warranted.
- 2 That when ceiling insulation is sampled, that National Australian Testing Authorities (NATA) air monitoring be undertaken to ensure that airborne concentrations are below the detection limit (i.e. So, that no-one was exposed during this procedure). This would potentially protect the NSW government from future litigious ramifications.
