I am concerned about the proliferation of guns in our Community (Narooma) by way of a HuntFest currently held on Crown Lands in Narooma.

This matter is currently before the Minister for Crown Lands to consider granting a further extension of HuntFest's current licence which expires in 2017. Despite 80% of the locals opposing such an event, our local Council erroneously decided to endorse a further 5 year licence to HuntFest in our Shire. The Minister for Crown Lands (and other relevant Ministers) have been fully briefed of the community's concerns on a number of occasions and by a number of locals, including the presentation to Parliament of a petition with over 10,000 signature opposing the sale of guns on Crown Land.
