Inquiry into Crown Land

Attached is a copy of a submission sent to the General Manager of the Eurobodalla Shire Council (the ESC) in October 2014 by the Narooma Branch of the Australian Labor Party opposing a proposal by the South Coast Hunters Club for the ESC to approve gun sales in publicly owned facilities located on crown land in Narooma.

Despite those representations and an overwhelming number of other submissions from shire residents and organisations opposing gun sales, the ESC approved the proposal at the Council's meeting on 25 November 2014. More recently, at its meeting of 22 March 2016, the ESC has extended that gun sales approval through to 2022.

It would be appreciated if the views of our members, as set out in our letter to the ESC of 8 October 2014, could be taken into consideration by the members of your committee in their deliberations over this matter.
