INQUIRY INTO CROWN LAND

Please accept this submission not as an individual submission but as many millions of submissions by individuals in NSW who may not be aware of the Inquiry but who agree that Crown Land should not be privatised or commercialised.

The current push to capitalise on the commercial potential of Crown Lands benefits individuals or at best minority groups at the expense of the wider community.
