I'm writing with regards to the Upper House Inquiry into the Enrolment capacity in inner city public primary schools, focusing on Ultimo Public School, in particular.

I would like the Department of Education to consider leaving Ultimo Public School as it currently is -- there's been a lot of unnecessary heartache and drama over the last few years. Rather than demolishing or moving the school, why not build a SECOND primary school in Pymont instead, even if only an infant school comprising years K-2?
