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My mother, Patricia Holt, aged 83 years, who has been a private patient of Dr Phadke, has been very happy with the treatment he has given her and has every confidence in him. She has thrived in his care, largely because he is prepared to individualise the treatment to the particular patient.

We would trust in Dr Phadke's experience over a set of medical protocols any day. When my mother was admitted to Sutherland Hospital with pneumonia in 2014 there were some doctors at the hospital who wished to give her a bone marrow biopsy against her stated wishes. We deplore the haste to judgement of him evident in the media as we feel strongly, from our own experience, that Dr Phadke would always act in the interests of his patients.
