In 2003 I was diagnosed with Multiple Myeloma (bone cancer)

I was advised to see Dr. Phadki to get his advice on treatment

This treatment involved chemotherapy. This treatment was not clear cut to destroy the Cancer, and it was decided to change and start another type of Chemo.

At this point of time Doctor                      was asked to take over my case, I noting that Dr. Phadki was in my view extremely busy with so many patients and answering questions from his Resident Doctors and many other people involved in the ongoing treatment

His resident Doctors were also involved in my case and with other patients

Doctor Phadki, would often call and check my progress while in hospital

With many years of Chemo, and other treatment, I was asked to undergo Stem Cell Transplant, with great success.
