Re: Submission to the Inquiry into museums and galleries

I refer to the above inquiry.

The Powerhouse Museum is an important cultural institution to the City of Sydney and I strongly support it remaining in its current location in Ultimo.

I strongly support the people of Parramatta having their own cultural facility to tell the stories of their local community.

The City's planned Cultural Ribbon is the driving force behind the city's cultural policy, tying together all of the important cultural institutions of the City of Sydney.

The City's planned Cultural Ribbon originally included the Powerhouse Museum as major cultural institution.

At the December meeting of Council, the Lord Mayor submitted a draft Cultural Ribbon plan that would remove the Powerhouse Museum from the Cultural Ribbon.
