Good morning I am making a submission in relation to the proposed toll on the M4. For those who must use the M4 at least twice daily to get to and from their place of employment the toll is going to create real financial hardship. If for eg you were travelling from St Marys this would set you back about an extra \$50 per week. Taking into account Public Holidays and Annual Leave you are still looking at the best part of \$2500 per annum being added onto the cost of your daily commute.
