I note in the Traffic Impact Assessment of the EIS for the energy from waste project. . In 6.1.4 table 5 the total traffic movements are shown as 454 a day. this will have a negative affect on the area as the roads are already overcrowded. But worse than this the hourly number of vehicles is is 53 (53 times 24 is way more than 454) that makes 1272. which is the correct figure? well it really doesn't matter the roads cannot cope with an extra 454 without the larger number and potential increases when the project opens.

The report doesn't mention how many extra vehicles will go to Genesis Xero Material Processing Centre to the join the conveyer to the site. traffic management is a major problem with this project I urge that there be permanent maximum number of vehicles per day allowed to use the site and that should there be a request to increase this number there should be an impact statement and further public submissions before any changes.
