I opposed the development of the proposed energy from waste facility at Eastern Creek for a multitude of reasons. Most notably, the fact that the company responsible for this development cannot confirm what final emissions will be. Next generation have told us that there will be an increase in the spread of ultrafine particulates and these are known to cause respiratory and cardiac disease. There are also no current environmental controls or legislation that are applicable to an incinerator this size - the world's largest.

Both the local council and Western Sydney Local Health District have opposed this project, indicating their are serious concerns about the risks related to this project yet the Next Generation has failed to both adequately inform residents and has not been able to provide satisfactory answers to our questions. For the sake of the community and families who live literally merely 800metres away from the proposed site I urge you not to proceed with this proposed facility.
