Re: Proposed incinerator Eastern Creek

We would like to place the following submission regarding the above proposal:

Eastern Creek is already disadvantaged with the existence of the Eastern Creek Waste Management Centre on Wallgrove Road. This Centre causes a terrible odour! The area is growing in population as a business centre, catering for thousands of people who spend most of their lives there. The Eastern Creek Business Park houses not only factories but many offices and restaurants and other retail businesses.
