I wish to express my disapproval and concern with the incinerator complex planned for Eastern Creek,

I understand that there is not a complete understanding of the pollution fall out from this incinerator. There is no guarantee that we will not have health issues in the future from this Incinerator,

Minchinbury's closest backyard is estimated only to be 800 meters away from the complex across the M4 highway, with 2 x 100 meters smoke stacks we are in the extreme fall out area. I have grave concerns that this Incinerator will not help our local people's health and our area.

I have lived in the western suburbs all my life, I grew up in Lethbridge Park (Mt Druitt) then married and moved to Minchinbury.
