INQUIRY INTO ELECTRICITY SUPPLY, DEMAND AND PRICES IN NEW SOUTH WALES

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On peak demand days energy wholesalers make \$1000s /kWh on provision of power to the grid. Many wholesalers obtain some of that energy from domestic solar installation and pay the standard rate of \$0.128 kWh. A massive rip off to domestic suppliers.

Intervention is required to:

Return a fair price on high demand days to domestic suppliers; Inject competition between wholesale suppliers for the energy produced by domestic suppliers.

Encourage greater uptake of domestic solar and in doing so, reduce demand on the grid.
