When I look at what I have to pay to for electricity (\$0.25 to \$0.40/kw hour) when I don't have enough solar, I feel that I am being well & truly ripped off when I get my \$0.11/kw hour. What is the go here.

Also, on really hot days when I am not using all my solar PV but the grid is getting squeezed I feel that I should be paid much more.
