I am writing this short submission in support of legislated minimum feed in tariff which truly reflects the value of solar generation.

I am totally disappointed with my energy company, Origin, which raised my peak usage charge when they increased the solar feed in tariff as below:

To 30th June I paid 24.2 cents/kwh and was credited 6 cents for feed in.

From 1 July they charged me 28.47 cents/kwh (up 4.27 cents) and only raised the feed in to 9 cents (up 3 cents). I have more than paid for the increase benefit from feed in.

I am also furious that they cannot supply me with a smart net meter and have had to pay a Level 2 Electrician to alter the wiring to my meter so that I use my power when the unit is generating
