I installed solar panels for two reasons, to save money and to contribute to helping the environment. My excess power from the sun is fed back into the grid for which the retailers pay 6c/kwh or in some instances 14c/kwh. This power is mostly generated between 10am-2pm, which co-incides with the times when retailers charge peak rates to householders, which is currently about 52c/kwh.
