I provide copy of letter forwarded to NSW Police Commissioner Mick Fuller, regards significant misuse of publicly funded police resources to sabotage an official police complaint re misconduct and to decline work cover claim

I live in Queensland and have only just been made aware of Inquiry into Emergency Services NSW.

Earlier this year work cover claim was accepted.

The facts in support of my work cover claim are no different in 2017, than they were in 2011. Its the extraordinary lengths and underhanded tactics used by NSW police and EML to frustrate and decline both matters, over past six years, which goes against core policing values, law and caused unjustifiable waste of public funds.

As a tax payer, I find the waste of tax dollars to decline rights is deplorable.

I ask you to intervene and discuss the issues raised within the attached letter with NSW Police Commissioner Fuller.

Even though late, I ask that my original complaint file sent to NSW Government and letter dated 4/10/2017, addressed to NSW Police Commissioner, be considered and presented during your Inquiry into Emergency Service NSW.

No police officer should ever experience reprisals and be denied assistance because NSWP are unwilling to acknowledge or respond appropriately to workplace harassment or bullying.
