This letter is my submission to the Windsor Bridge Inquiry. My submission is to reflection of my opposition to the Governments proposal to build a bridge 35m downstream of the existing historic Windsor Bridge.

I have been in the area for 22 years and owning two properties one in Kurrajong and one in Windsor. I have experienced the daily commute across the bridge for 10 years and have seen Sydney siders fall in love with Windsor slowly.

My first complaint would be that you are building a bridge that will not improve congestion or traffic flow in the town of Windsor. A new bridge with three lanes built in the middle of such historic buildings is senseless and destructive to our nations heritage. With the increase in population and urban sprawl visitors to Windsor to understand our history and enjoy the river is increasing significantly.
