Please accept this correspondence as my submission in respect to the Windsor Bridge Inquiry. While making my submission I wish to register my opposition and objection to the Governments proposal to build this new bridge 35m downstream of the existing Historical Bridge. From the information I have read I believe it will make little difference in making traffic flow better or in future flooding as confirmed in Project EIS.
