I would simply like to present three images of Windsor which speak for themselves.

They show a clear example of the Heritage preservation, Flood immunity and 'Purpose' of the prior RMS bridge replacement project in Windsor.

Only just over the hill, a few hundred metres down the road from the currently proposed Flood Free and Heritage Protecting Bridge Replacement project, until 1976, at the gateway to Windsor, once stood a beautiful Toll House.

It actually still stands there, but few would know it.....

BEFORE:
