
## INQUIRY INTO WINDSOR BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

I would like to register my complete opposition to the proposal to replace historic Windsor Bridge with a like for like concrete bridge 35m downriver from the current crossing that will not alleviate traffic congestion, flooding and will ultimately do irreparable damage to the Thompson Square historic precinct.

How can the thousands of registered objections, as well as documentation from government departments to the effect that this is not a sustainable or viable solution, be totally tossed aside for this ridiculous project.

The current bridge just need some maintenance to keep it in good working order (as documented in RMS findings) for local traffic and put the 3000 plus trucks that are increasing in numbers over the years onto a by-pass and keep the old bridge as is.

Thompson Square is well worth preserving for its historical significance in the building of our early colonies but the destruction that is continuing on even before this inquiry has begun is criminal and truckloads of finds are being removed everyday and the destruction of the colonial built barrel drains is on going.
