I am totally against the current plan by the Government to destroy Thompson Square and Windsor Bridge, for the following reasons:

Although there will be a new bridge, there will still be flooding from Wilberforce to Windsor along Wilberforce Road and Freemans reach Road, so the objective 1 in 5 flood immunity is not met.

Although there will be an extra lane on the new bridge, congestion will still occur at the surrounding intersections to beyond acceptable levels.

Thompson Square can never be replaced.

Most traffic coming into Windsor carry on. They do not appear to stop in Windsor itself. Only locals visit Windsor for shopping, etc. except for week-ends. This through traffic should be diverted.
