I do not support this proposal for the following reasons:-

The location for major sports and entertainment facilities should be in Western Sydney where the larger population resides which demands such facilities and Not on the city fringe with inadequate public transport.

Unanswered traffic and parking problems associated with the SCG/SFS still exist after many years. What are the current proposals? The City and South East Light Rail fiasco will not be able to adequately address these problems. The convenience and flexibility of car transport is part of living standards in this city.

The proposal is not just about sports - it is about creating a multi-complex entertainment precinct. Again, it is the population of Western Sydney which demands these facilities.

Infrastructure NSW is giving a timeframe of six months to assess the project - a fast determination for a project of this size and complexity. The Government appears to be fast tracking an approval so demolition of the current stadium can occur before the next election.
