I believe the Parramatta Stadium development to be based on false analysis and inadequate planning and consultation. It does not represent the wishes of the people of western Sydney, or more importantly the local Parramatta community. The proposed useage plans are fanciful. Only one rugby league team and one football team will use it, and nit for all their home games. No other use has yet been licked in. In return we have lost a valuable community resource, the memorial pool, which had only recently been refurbished. Despite alternatives bring offered by the community, no proper consultation or consideration was made, and the stadium and demolition of the pool were forced through by the government appointed administrator, not an elected council. This blatant disregard for due process and community wishes is typical of this current government, asebfenced by other development proposals' and the misuse of Parramatta park lands. Please investigate the processes used to authorise this development and the misuse of public money for the gain of a very few people
